Horse and Horse Stall Equipment

Each competitor must have their own. Each item should be labeled with competitor's name or club or competitor number.

_____ 1 heavy-duty feed tub/bucket

_____ 2 (5 gal.) heavy-duty water buckets (1 marked 'Fresh Water', 1 marked 'With Electrolytes', if used)

_____ 1 (5 gal.) water bucket, filled at night, to top off water buckets at late night.

(Stored empty in tack room during day)

_____ Lead rope (cotton, leather or nylon all acceptable)

_____ Extra halter

_____ Salt block (holder optional; loose salt acceptable)

_____ Extra snaps for tubs & buckets

_____ Horse I.D. (stall card)

Feeding Equipment (per horse)

_____ All feed and hay must be prepared and labeled in such a way that anyone, whether a member of the team or any other individual, is able to step in and feed each mount in the absence of the owner/rider.

Feed can be pre-packaged in PAPER bags (or other non-airtight, breathable container) – one feeding per container. Each container should be clearly labeled with name of mount, and when the 'meal' will be fed (morning, mid-day or evening). All containers need to be placed in a secure container with a lid that a horse cannot remove. (See 2016 Horse Management Rulebook, Section 13d, Hay/Roughage, Concentrates / Grain & Supplements, page 19 for more information.)

EX: Joey (the pony's name), Wed. PM feeding,.

Stall Cleaning Equipment (only one of each is needed for each shared tack stall)

- _____ Broom
- _____ Manure basket or wheelbarrow

Each competitor should know where their team's/club's extra equipment is located or have the following items of their own and know where it is stored.

- _____ Thumbtacks
- _____ 2 USPC pins
